Employees can reach senior management directly through the established "Band-Up" system. We also encourage our employees' creative ideas regarding facility operations and practices.



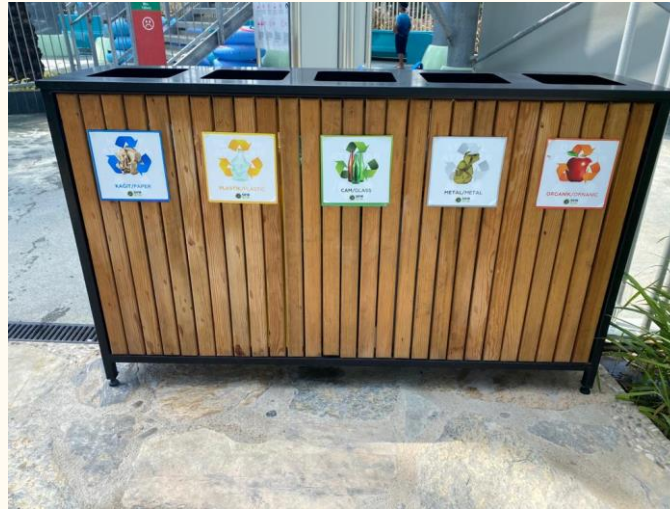

ELECTRIC CAR CHARGING STATION

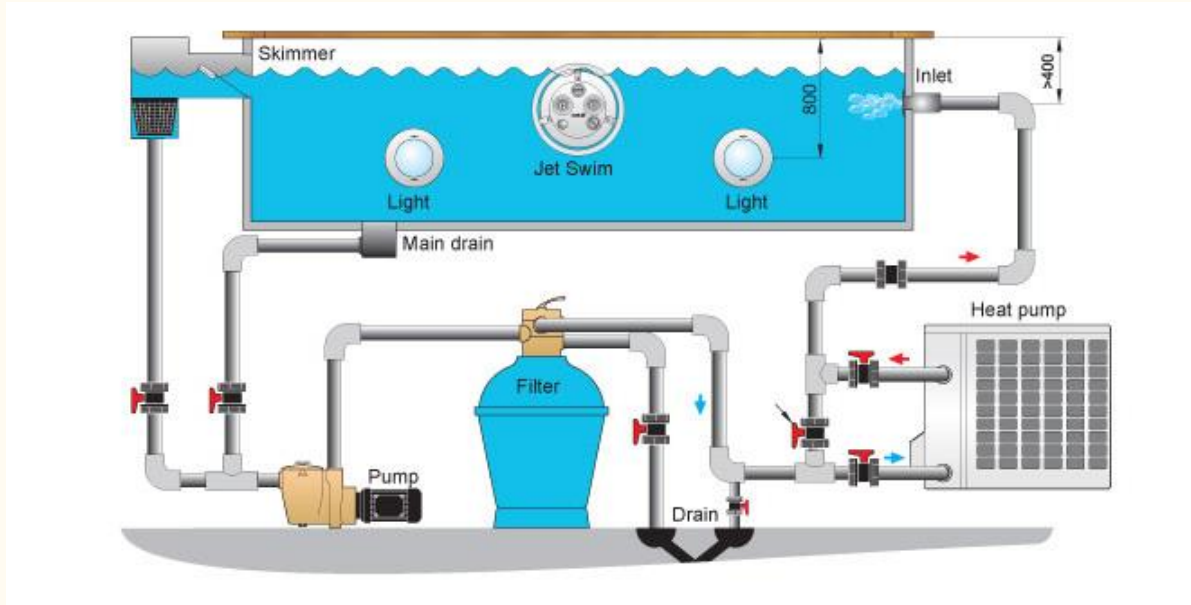
The buggies and hotel vehicles are electric.

Heat pumps are used for heating heated pools. Heat pumps use electricity generated from renewable sources (HES, RES, GES).



SOLAR PANELS

There are 110 solar panels used for water heating.



WATER SAVING

*Sensor faucets, sensor urinals, timed foot washing units on the beach, knee-strike timed sink faucets are used in production areas.

*Water saving is ensured by adjusting the flow rate in bathroom faucets, sink faucets and toilet bowl reservoirs.

*Flow rates of shower and faucet mixers are measured regularly.

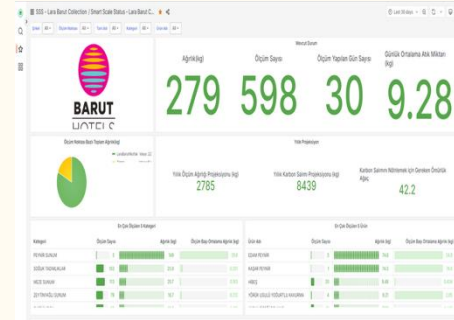
AUTOMATION IRRIGATION SYSTEM

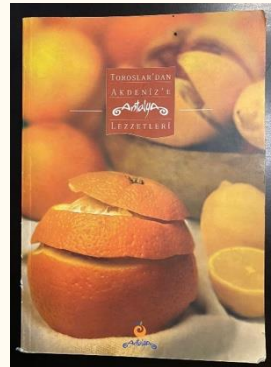
New Year's decorations for the year 2024 have been made by our Activities and Entertainment department in our hotel.

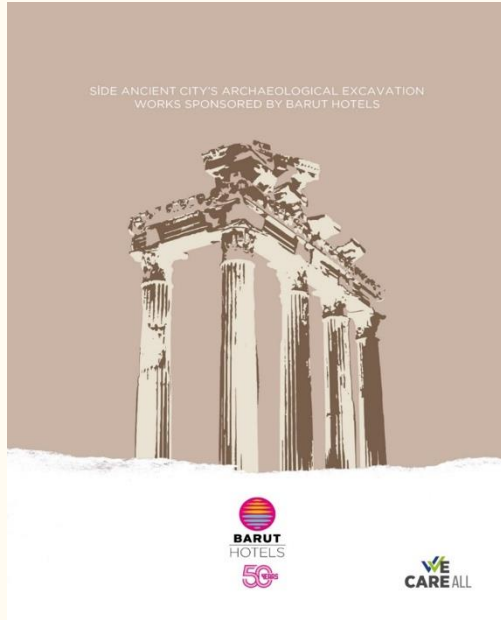
CAT HOUSE
